and to give Tzedakah to Survivors in need.

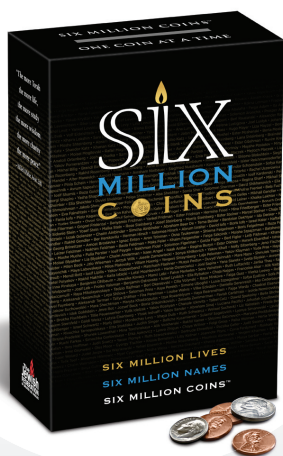
